

## **Carmel Sheppard CLC Site Supervisor Award**

**DESCRIPTION:** Carmel Sheppard was passionate about equity in academic and social experiences for all students. She believed poor students and children of color can learn and achieve, and that a broad variety of social and cultural experiences was important for students who would not have those experiences in their daily lives (e.g. golf lessons for Dawes students).

Carmel was also passionate about increasing success and graduation opportunities for her students, and the totality of involvement of the adults in students' lives—every staff member, parents, community (school community, Lincoln community), business and non-profit partners. She appreciated and was sensitive to cultural diversity.

Carmel was a highly skilled, competent professional, but her mission was based in the fact that she absolutely loved all the children in her school. She knew them, their families, their siblings, their neighborhoods. Their achievements became her celebration; their challenges were her opportunities to assist them in creating change.

The Carmel Sheppard CLC Site Supervisor Award was created in 2008 to recognize outstanding site supervisors within the Lincoln Community Learning Centers. The award will be between \$2,000 and \$2,500, and nominations will be accepted annually.

**NOMINATION:** Elementary and Middle School Principals may nominate CLC site supervisors for the Carmel Sheppard CLC Site Supervisor Award. Nominations should be made keeping the following criteria in mind:

- Longevity
- Outcomes (quantifiable)
- Impact (anecdotal—stories about how children and families have benefited)
- Consistency
- Inclusion of stakeholders

**TO NOMINATE:** To nominate an outstanding CLC site supervisor, complete the information on the next page, and attach no more than one additional page.

Submit nominations to Foundation for Lincoln Public Schools, Attn: Carmel Sheppard CLC Award, 5901 O Street, Lincoln, NE 68510. **Nominations are due by March 1 each year.**

**SELECTION:** The award will be selected by the Foundation for Lincoln Public Schools, with recommendations from the executive committee of the CLC Leadership Council or an ad hoc group chosen by the Council to do the selection. The committee will be chaired by Nancy Fuchs. The selection committee may decide not to select a winner for this award each year from the nominations received.
