## ***Outstanding Mathematics Educator Award***

***Available to Lincoln Public Schools Mathematics Educators***

The Myrtle Clark award was established by a former student to honor Miss Myrtle Clark, a former mathematics teacher at Lincoln Northeast High School and Jackson High School. The award is given to recognize excellence in mathematics teaching and provide a source of funding for LPS mathematics educators for summer school courses to advance teaching skills or for pursuit of an advanced degree in mathematics. The award amount shall be determined annually and currently provides a \$1,000 award.

**SELECTION CRITERIA:** The Foundation for Lincoln Public Schools Awards and Grants Committee will serve as the selection committee with input from the LPS Curriculum Specialist for Mathematics.

They will base their decision on the following criteria:

- Citizen of the United States,
- Mathematics educator for the Lincoln Public Schools,
- Commitment to excellence in mathematics teaching,
- Interest in pursuing summer school courses to advance teaching skills or an advanced degree in mathematics.

**TO APPLY:** Any LPS educator meeting the above criteria may complete the Myrtle Clark application form.

**TIMELINE:** Applications are due to the Foundation by March 15 of each year.
