

MATHEMATICS EMERITUS FACULTY AWARD FOR LPS TEACHERS OF MATHEMATICS

Teachers of Mathematics in All Lincoln Public Schools

DESCRIPTION: This Fund was created by Lincoln mathematics educators to assist current LPS teachers in earning their advanced degrees in mathematics or mathematics education. The Fund is intended to help in the same way as the National Science Foundation financially assisted educators in years past. This endowed Fund is built from current and future donations from retired and current math teachers and outstanding graduates from Lincoln's public high schools, as well as gifts from friends and family honoring great math teachers and others.

It is anticipated the annual award(s) may range between \$500 and \$1,000. Currently the award is \$500.

SELECTION CRITERIA: The recipient(s) will be chosen by the LPS Mathematics Curriculum Specialist's selection committee, in conjunction with the Foundation for Lincoln Public Schools Awards and Grants Committee.

This award is available to teachers who meet the following criteria:

- Current teachers of mathematics in Lincoln Public Schools.
- Demonstrated commitment to excellence in mathematics teaching.
- Accepted in an advanced mathematics degree program at any accredited institution.

TO APPLY: By March 15, send a 1-page letter to the LPS Mathematics Curriculum Specialist indicating why you should be selected for the award. The recipient(s) must send a tuition statement or comparable validation of enrollment fees in an advanced degree program, to the Foundation for Lincoln Public Schools so the award monies can be sent directly to the institution.
