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**NEW FUNDS**

**#20865 LEH Class of 1973 Scholarship**

*Temporarily Restricted*

Established by the Lincoln East High School Class of 1973, annual scholarships will be awarded to a graduating senior at Lincoln East High School.

**#38043 Funds Pending Allocation for FANs**

*Pass Through*

This fund is a repository for undesignated Fund a Need gifts and grants that will require allocation in the future as determined by donor intent and campaign needs. Gifts received will be marked for Fund a Need and be paid out as such.

**#38044 Bay High Focus Program Fund for Excellence**

*Pass Through*

This is a discretionary fund that is available for the Bay High Focus Program director to spend as they see fit. Its uses can include, but are not limited to: classroom supplies, field trips, technology, staff development, food for staff meetings, food for classroom celebrations, to bring in a speaker, to buy a winter coat for a Bay High student, to help a Bay High family with rent, utility bills, medical emergencies, etc., and more.

**#48133 Bill and Deb Sesow Memorial Scholarship**

*Permanently Restricted*

Established to honor the contributions Bill and Deb Sesow made to students and future educators at Lincoln Public Schools and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, this scholarship supports LPS graduating seniors planning to pursue a degree in education at a 2-year or 4-year accredited college or university, with preference given to student who demonstrates financial need.

**#48134 Lynne Faulkner Art Experience Memorial Fund**

*Permanently Restricted*

Established to honor the memory of Lynne Faulkner, an art teacher and art specialist at Clinton and Cavett elementary schools for 30 years. Grants from this fund will cover the costs associated with a field trip, such as transportation, entry fees, specialized materials required for the trip, and the participation of an LPS art specialist. The field trip shall enhance students' understanding and



appreciation of the arts, including visits to museums, galleries, artist workshops, performances, or other arts-related educational experiences.

**AMENDED FUNDS**

**#20278 Dolores N. Mather Award for Language Arts Teaching**

*Temporarily Restricted*

This fund was amended to update the schools at which eligible teachers may work and to change the time limit required for course work in language arts at an accredited college or university.
